

Stripe Quilt

Supply List

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This class will teach you the technique. If you want a larger quilt, obviously, you will need more fabrics. This class is planned to make a 'baby' sized quilt top.

Book – “Wonderful 1 Fabric Quilts” by Kay Nickols (recommended)

Fabrics – 1-1/2 yard of striped fabric (minimum)

Look for uneven stripes and color contrast

Evenly spaced stripes and monochromatic colors are not as effective

A contrasting fabric or two as possibilities for sashing, if you want it. – Won't know for sure until you lay out the blocks

Rotary cutter and mat and straight ruler (at least 18” long)

12” or 12-1/2” Square ruler

Writing instrument (to jot notes)

Thread

Sewing machine

¼” foot (recommended)

Basic Sewing supplies

Seam ripper!!!

pins

Flannel backed table cloth (Cheap!) To use to layout pattern and be able to take home what you don't finish. You should be able to find one at the dollar store.

Optional:

“grippers” for your template (very helpful to keep template from sliding)

Tiny stickers (I will have these for you)

Spray starch (I will have this available)
