

This would be a great way to use scraps but we're going to do it in blues and whites. You may use either a dark or a medium blue. Prints are OK but should read as dark or medium blue. For the white, you may use white on white or light cream or ecru. Try to keep your selection very light so there will be contrast.

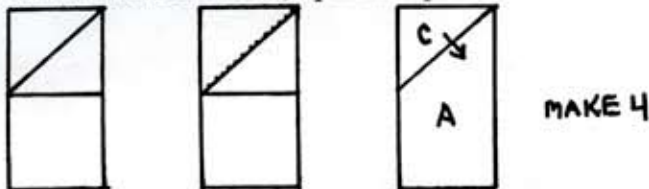
- From the blue, cut:
- 4 each 3" x 5 1/2" rectangles (A)
- 2 each 3 1/2" squares (B)
- From the white or cream, cut:
- 4 each 3" squares (C)
- 4 each 3" squares (D)
- 2 each 3 1/2" squares (E)



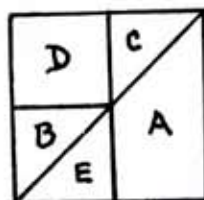
First make half square triangles using the 3 1/2" blue and white squares. Right sides together, draw a diagonal line on back of white square, stitch 1/4" on each side of the drawn line, cut on drawn line, open and press to blue. Makes two units. Repeat with the other 3 1/2" blue and white squares. Total 4 units. Square all to measure 3".



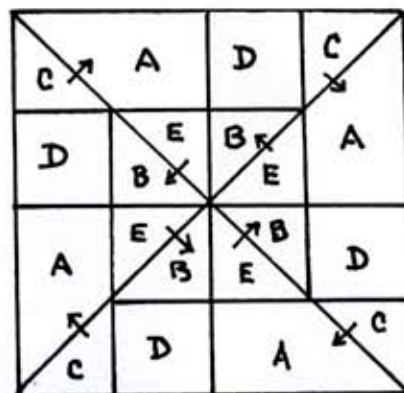
Next, place a 3" white square (C) face down on the end of a 3" x 5 1/2" blue rectangle (A) and draw a diagonal line on the back of the white square from LOWER LEFT corner to UPPER RIGHT corner. Stitch just a tad to the outside of the drawn line. Cut away corner 1/4" from seam line, open and press to blue. Make 4 units. Square to 3" x 5 1/2".



Assemble, following small diagram below left. Make four units. Then, follow the piecing diagram below, right, making sure each unit is turned 1/4 turn to right. If you have any problems or questions, please call GLENNA (830)996-3069
