



This should be a fun block that we are going to do with batiks. You'll need a light and a dark. Please make sure you have a good contrast.

From the light cut:

2 each 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles (A)

2 each 2 1/2" x 3" rectangles (B)

2 each 2 1/2" x 2" rectangles (C)

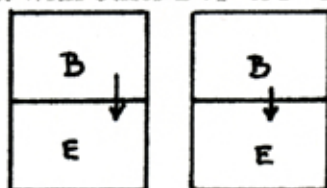
From the dark cut:

4 each 2 1/2" x 3" rectangles (2 each for D)(2 each for E)

2 each 2" x 4 1/2" rectangles (F)

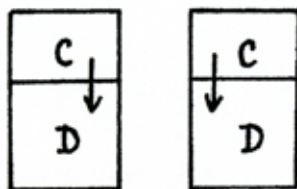
Place a 2 1/2" x 3" light rectangle (B) with a 2 1/2" x 3" dark rectangle (E) right sides together and stitch 1/4" seam on 3" side. Open and press to dark.

Repeat with other 2 1/2" x 3" B & E rectangles. Make 2 units (Fig. 1)

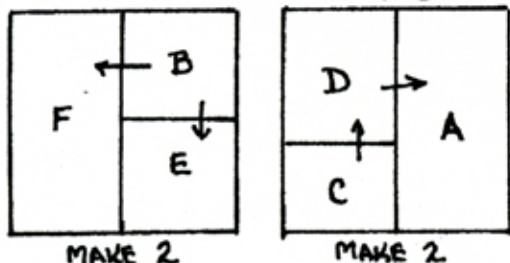


Place a 2 1/2" x 2" light rectangle (C) face down on one end of a 2 1/2" x 3" dark rectangle (D) and stitch 1/4" seam on 2 1/2" side. Open and press to dark.

Repeat with remaining 2 1/2" x 2" light and 2 1/2" x 3" dark rectangles (Fig. 2)



Assemble sections (Figs. 3 & 4)



Assemble your block using piecing diagram. →  
 Completed block should measure 8 1/2"
