

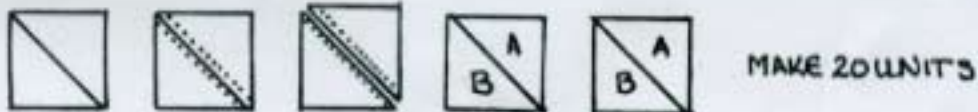


This block should get you in the mood for some cooler weather. We're going to use fall colors for a really great scrap quilt. You will need a cream or ecru (no white, please) and your choice of red, orange, gold, yellow, rust, burgundy brown or maybe a dark green. From your cream or ecru, (A) cut:

4 each 3 1/2" squares (lay these aside away from your cutting surface) and
1 each 2 1/2" x 25 1/4" strip

From your fall fabric (B) cut:
1 each 2 1/2" x 25 1/4" strip

Place the 2 1/2" x 25 1/4" strips, right sides together and cut into 10 each 2 1/2" squares. Draw a diagonal line on back of light (A) squares. Stitch 1/4" on each side of the drawn line, cut on drawn line, open and press to dark (B). You will have two half-square triangle units. Repeat with remaining nine A/B square sets for a total of 20 half-square triangle units. Square all to measure 2".



Assemble your block following piecing diagrams below. Arrows represent suggested pressing direction. Completed block should measure 9 1/2" (9" finished). If you have any problems or questions, please call GLENNA (830)996-3069.
