

# PIECE AND GOODWILL

This block is from Diane Harris with a modification and will be our Christmas block this year. We all have reds, greens, creams and whites and probably some Christmas fabrics, so we'll be using these.

Cut:

One 2" x 8 1/8" strip & one 2" x 4" strip from the red (R)

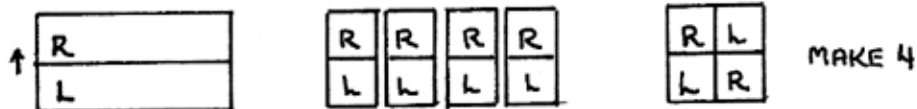
One 2" x 8 1/8" strip & one 2" x 4" strip from the green (G)

Two 2" x 8 1/8" strips white or cream (L)

One 2" x 16 1/4" white or cream (L) sub-cut into 8 each 2" squares

Four 3 1/2" squares Christmas fabric (X)

Stitch together the long sides of the 2" x 8 1/8" red (R) strip and the 2" x 8 1/8" cream (L) strip. Press to red and cut strip into four (4) 2" segments. Assemble two 4-patch units and square both to measure 3 1/2".



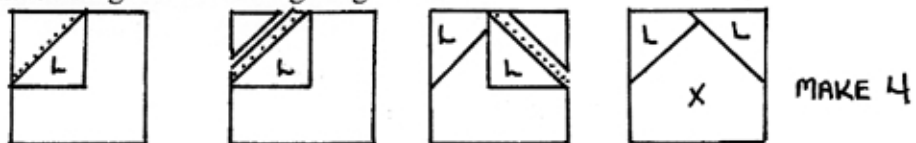
Repeat the procedure using the 2" x 8 1/8" green (G) strip and the remaining 2" x 8 1/8" cream (L) strip. Press to green and cut into four (4) 2" segments. Assemble two 4-patch units and square both to measure 3 1/2".



Stitch together the long sides of the 2: x 4: red (R) and green (G) strips, press to green and cut into two 2" segments. Assemble one 4-patch unit and square to measure 3 1/2".

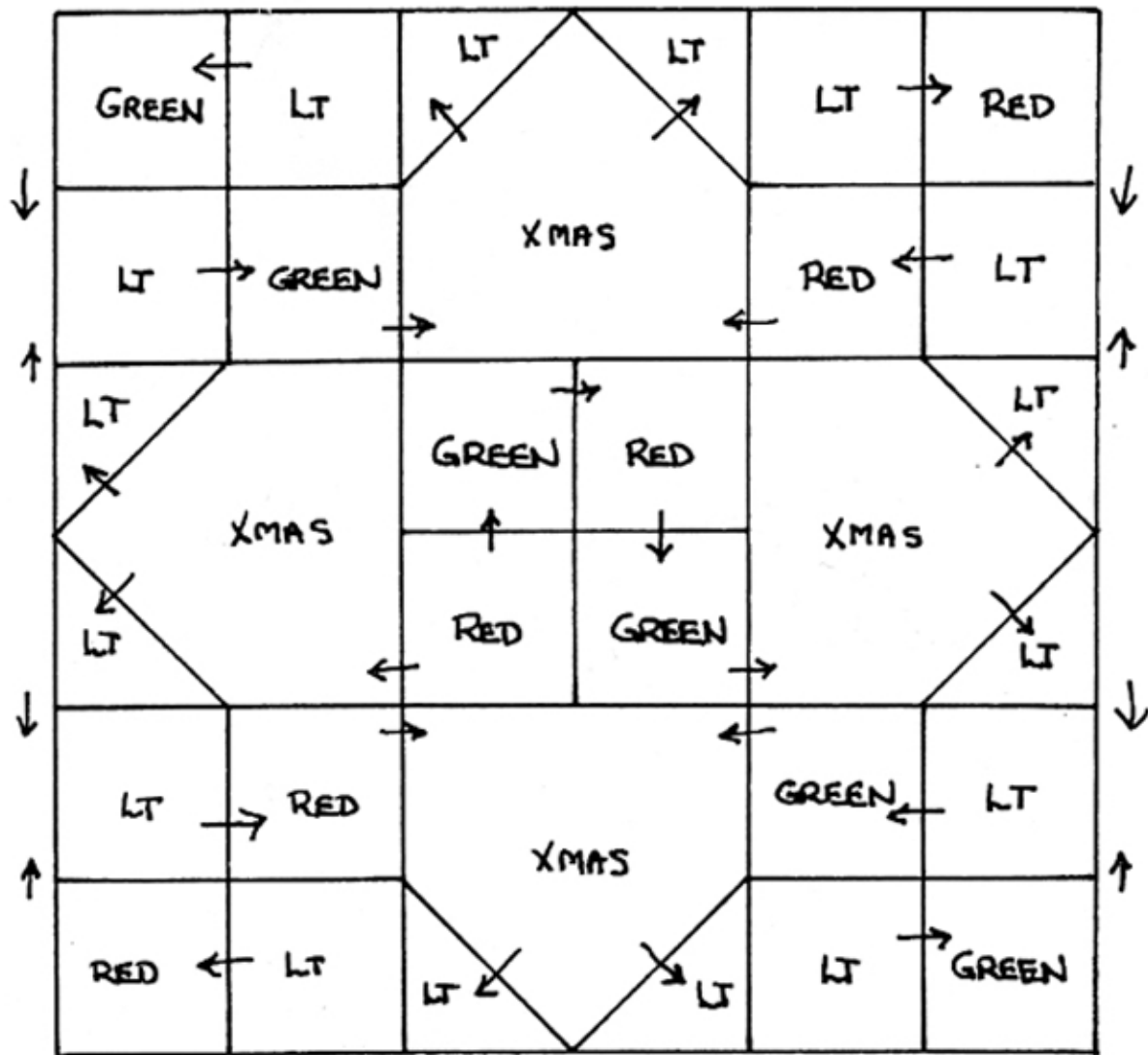


With the remaining 2" white or cream squares and the 3 1/2" Christmas fabric (X) squares, assemble your side units using the following diagrams:



Please a light (L) square face down on upper left corner. Draw a diagonal line lower left to upper right and stitch just a tad to the outside of the drawn line. Cut away 1/4" from seam line and press to light. Place another light (L) square face down on the upper right corner. Draw a diagonal line upper left to lower right and stitch just a tad to the outside of the drawn line. Cut away corner 1/4" from seam line and press to light. Make four (4) units and square to measure 3 1/2".
