



This is going to be a pretty quilt with lots of colorful flowers. The blue fabric for the pot is furnished but you will need a white (tone on tone is fine but NO PRINTS), three different "flower" fabrics, a bright yellow for your "centers" and a nice green for the stems and leaf. Here we go!

From the white (A) cut: 5 each 4 1/2" squares 3 each 3" squares and 1 strip 1 1/2" x 16 3/8" (subcut into one 1 1/2" x 4 5/8" strip, three 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles and two 1 1/2" squares)

From the yellow (B) cut: 1 strip 1 1/2" x 4 5/8" strip (goes with the white strip)

From three (3) different fabrics (C), (D) and (E) for the "flowers" cut: 1 each 3" square and 1 each 2 1/2" square Remember, three different fabrics!

From the green (F) cut: 1 each 1" x 6" strip and 1 each 1" x 3 1/2" strip BOTH ON THE BIAS and your leaf (use template and be sure to add whatever seam allowance you like).

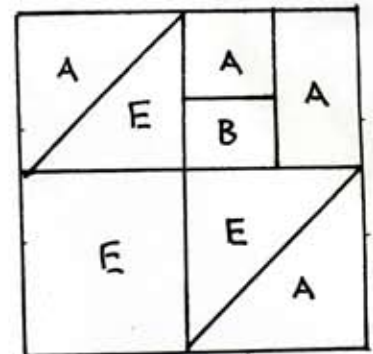
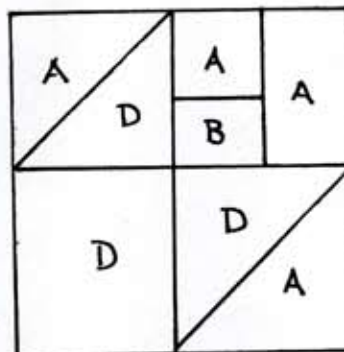
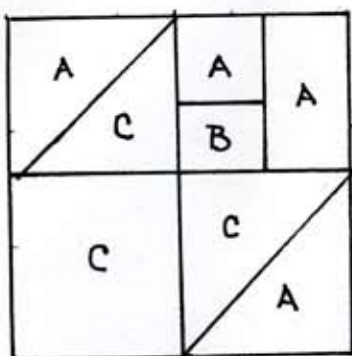
Place a 3" white square (A) face down on each of your three different "flower" fabric 3" squares (C), (D) and (E). Draw diagonal diagonal lines on backs of white squares, stitch 1/4" on each side of the drawn lines, cut on drawn lines, open and press to dark. You should have two half square triangle units of each color (C), (D) and (E). Square all units to measure 2 1/2".



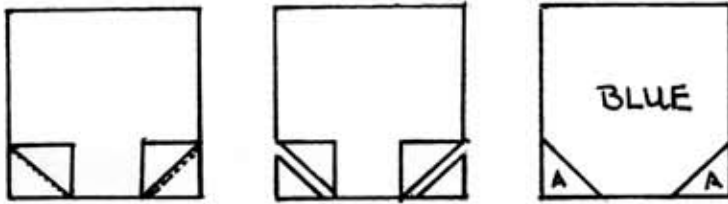
Stitch together long sides of the 1 1/2" x 4 5/8" white (A) and yellow (B) strips. Open and press to yellow. Cut into three 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" segments. Stitch a 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" white (A) rectangle to the RIGHT side of white/yellow segment making sure the yellow square is in the lower left corner. Make three (3).



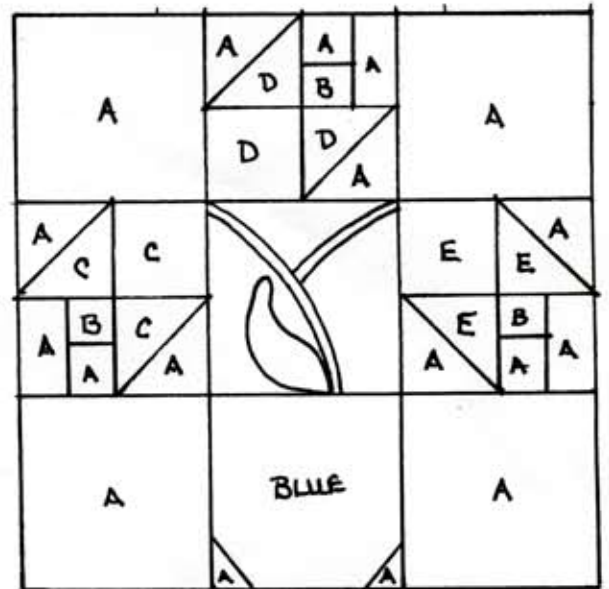
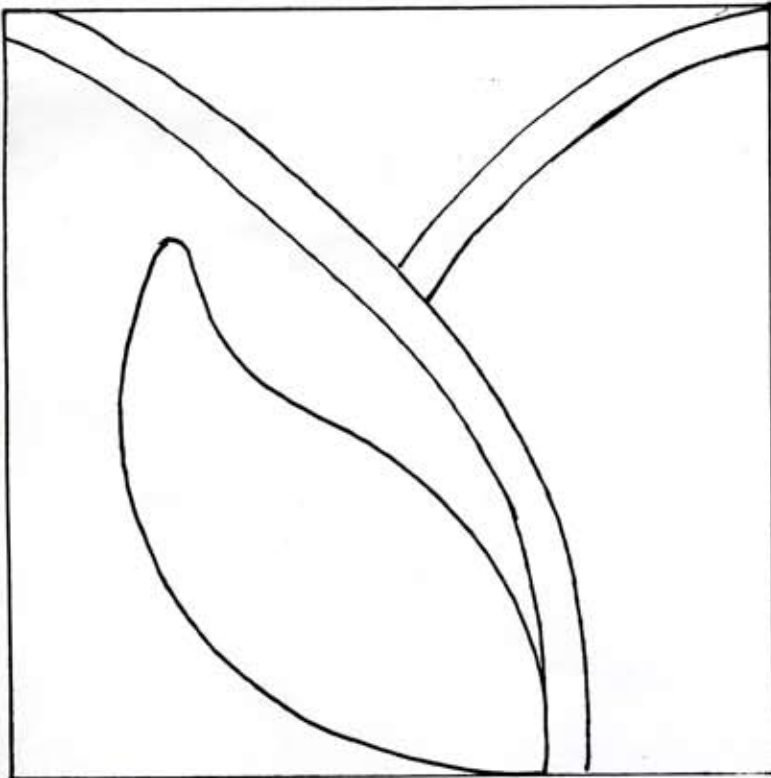
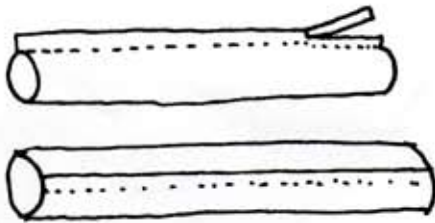
Assemble your three different "flowers" following diagram furnished below and square all units to measure 4 1/2". Notice that they are all made the same way but are placed differently when assembled into your block.



Now, using the 4 1/2" blue square that we furnished, place a 1 1/2" white square face down on bottom left and right corners and draw diagonal lines, as illustrated, on backs of white squares. Stitch just a tad to the outside of the drawn lines. Cut away corners, leaving 1/4" seam allowances, open and press to white. Square your "pot" to measure 4 1/2".



Now for the leaf and stems. This is the center of your block. Make sure your two stem strips are cut on the bias so they lay nice. Fold both strips lengthwise, **WRONG** sides together, and stitch 1/4" on long sides. Trim seam allowances to 1/8", then gently finger press your stem tubes so that seam is to the underside when placed on a 4 1/2" white (A) square. (See diagram for placement) Applique in place, short one first, then the long one, then add the leaf. Assemble your block using the piecing diagram attached.
