## New Braunfels Area Quilt Guild      2010 Quilt Show Rules

### Entry Information

1. Quilts must have been completed within the last 5 years, except for garments, which must have been completed since July, 2008. Entries must not have been entered in any previous NBAQG show.
2. Entry is free for NBAQG members. Entry fee for non-members is \$25 per entry.
3. There is a maximum of three (3) entries per person. Submit one form for each entry.
4. The entry form and applicable fees must be received by Saturday, May 01, 2010. This deadline will not be extended for any reason. Based on available space, the Quilt Show Chairs reserve the right to either limit the total number of entries received or shorten the deadline for entries.
5. Each entry form must include a color photograph for security and identification purposes only. Write your name on the back of the photo and attach it to the upper right corner of the entry form. Work in progress and computer generated printouts are acceptable.
6. Placement category and measurements of quilts shall be noted on the entry form.
7. All entries will be fully displayed for the entire length of the show except for unforeseen circumstances beyond the control of the Show.
8. **The Show Co-Chairs reserve the right to re-categorize entries if it is determined they have been entered in the wrong category. The Co-Chairs also reserve the right to refuse the entry of distasteful items or items that fail to meet entry criteria. Every effort will be made to communicate any change to the quilt maker.**

### Quilt Preparation

1. Entrants are responsible for insuring their entries. Group insurance is **NOT** available. Neither NBAQG, the Show Co-Chairs, nor the New Braunfels Civic/Convention Center Management shall be held liable for loss or damage to your entries.
2. Each entry shall have a fabric identification label with the maker's name sewn to the back of the quilt, or to the inside of the garment. Prior to judging, labels must be covered, preferably with hand-basted or safety-pinned fabric.
3. Entries must have a four-inch (4") sleeve securely attached to the TOP of the quilt. Entries without a sleeve will not be accepted.
4. Wearable Arts garments are to be submitted on hangers. Put your name on your hanger if you want it returned. All other entries will be enclosed in a plastic bag provided by the Show.
5. All entries must be clean and in good condition. No unfinished entries will be accepted.

### Delivery and Pick-Up of Entries

1. Entries must be delivered to the New Braunfels Civic/Convention Center, 380 S. Sequin St., New Braunfels, Texas on Wednesday July 21, 2010 from 5:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. Claim tickets will be issued and required to pick up entries.
2. Entries shall be picked up at the New Braunfels Civic/Convention Center after 5:00 p.m. on Sunday July 25, 2010. Absolutely no entries will be released before all quilts have been taken down and bagged. The claim ticket must be presented before an entry will be released. **All entries shall be picked up by 6:00 p.m.**

### Awards

1. First, second, third place and honorable mention awards will be given in each eligible category at the discretion of the judges. All awards may not be given in each category if judges feel the entries do not warrant such awards.
2. One set of awards will be given for all categories. Quilter will be acknowledged on the gallery cards and in the program, but ribbons will be awarded only to the entrant
3. Special awards include: Best of Show, Judges' Choice, Viewers' Choice, and Theme Quilt.

**ENTRY CATEGORIES**

**Master/Professional (M)** – If ANY of the following are TRUE, the entry is qualified for the Master/Professional category:

- has written a book or pattern on quilting or wearable art techniques
- sells quilts or garments he/she has made
- quilts for profit, such as professional machine quilters
- has won two or more blue ribbons over time in any quilt show (guild, county, state, multi-state, international)
- teaches any quilting technique for profit
- has displayed in the Master/Professional category of another guild

**Artisan (A)** – If none of the Master/Professional qualifications are met, the entry is qualified for the Artisan category.

**Seniors (S)** – Eligible only to those 65 years or older. In this division all entries will be judged together regardless of the placement category they fall under.

**Open (O)** - This category has no restrictions as to skill or age. All entries are judged together.

**Exhibit Only (E)** – An entry for display only. No judging or feedback will occur. The entry can be any technique, hand or machine quilted. This category is open to all ages and expertise levels.

**Explanation of definitions:**

"Any construction technique is acceptable" includes but is not limited to appliqué, reverse appliqué and piecing; as well as embroidery, dyeing, embellishment, painting, and any combination of these techniques.

"Any quilting technique is acceptable" includes hand quilting, machine quilting, and any combination of these two techniques. Except where indicated in a specific category, tying and bar tacking are NOT acceptable for judged quilts.

A "quilt" must have a top, batting, and backing sandwiched and secured together with quilting.

Note: Quilts must have been completed within the last 5 years, except for garments, which must have been completed since July, 2008. Entries must not have been entered in any previous NBAQG show.

**DEFINITION OF PLACEMENT CATEGORIES**

**100 – Senior Quilt (S)**

**Size:** any size acceptable

**Construction:** any technique is acceptable

**Quilting:** any technique acceptable

**Maker:** Must be 65 years or older

**200 – Theme Quilt (O)**

Quilt must relate to the show theme.

**Size:** any size acceptable

**Construction:** any technique is acceptable

**Quilting:** any technique is acceptable

**Maker:** can be made by 1 or more people

**Judging:** will be judged by a local dignitary

**300 – First Quilt (A)**

Must be the **FIRST** quilted project entered into a judged show.

**Size:** any size is acceptable

**Construction:** any technique is acceptable

**Quilting:** any technique is acceptable

**Maker:** construction must be done entirely by the entrant

**400 – Miniature Quilt (A, M)**

**Size:** 24" or less on longest side (max size of 24"x24")

**Construction:** Any technique is acceptable.

Entries must be in proportion to full size quilts.

**Quilting:** any technique is acceptable

**Maker:** can be made by **1 or more** people

**500 – Pieced / Handquilted (A, M)**

**Size:** any size acceptable

**Construction:** must be at least 70% pieced

**Quilting:** all hand quilting

**Maker:** must be the work of **1 or 2** people

**600 – Appliqué / Handquilted (A, M)**

**Size:** any size acceptable

**Construction:** must be at least 70% appliqué (hand or machine)

**Quilting:** all hand quilting

**Maker:** must be the work of **1 or 2** people

**700 – Bed Quilt-Pieced / Machine Quilted (A, M)**

**Size:** at least 72" on longest side and no less than 40" on shortest side

**Construction:** majority of the quilt front must be pieced

**Quilting:** entirely machine quilted

**Maker:** must be the work of **1 or 2** people

**800 – Bed Quilt-Appliqué / Machine Quilted (A, M)**

**Size:** at least 72" on longest side and no less than 40" on shortest side

**Construction:** must be 70% appliqué (hand or machine)

**Quilting:** entirely machine quilted

**Maker:** must be the work of **1 or 2** people

**900 – Bed Quilt / Mixed Techniques (A, M)**

Includes all others not mentioned above (anything that is not at least 70%, redwork, crazy quilts, yo-yos, embroidery – machine and /or hand, wool, dyeing, painting, or combination of these, etc...)

**Size:** at least 72" on longest side and no less than 40" on shortest side

**Construction:** any technique or combination of techniques is acceptable

**Quilting:** any technique or combination of techniques is acceptable

**Maker:** must be the work of **1 or 2** people

**1000 – Wall Quilt-Pieced / Machine Quilted (A, M)**

Any quilt intended to be hung on the wall for display

**Size:** any size is acceptable

**Construction:** must be at least 70% pieced

**Quilting:** entirely machine quilted

**Maker:** must be the work of **1 or 2** people

**1100 – Wall Quilt Appliqué / Machine Quilted (A, M)**

Any quilt intended to be hung on the wall for display

**Size:** any size is acceptable

**Construction:** must be 70% appliqué (hand or machine)

**Quilting:** entirely machine quilted

**Maker:** must be the work of **1 or 2** people

**1200 – Wall Quilt / Mixed Techniques (A, M)**

Includes all other not mentioned above (anything that is not at least 70%, redwork, crazy quilts, yo-yos, embroidery – machine and /or hand, wool, dyeing, painting, or combination of these, etc...)

**Size:** any size is acceptable as long as it is intended to be hung on the wall for display

**Construction/Quilting:** any technique or combination of techniques is acceptable

**Maker:** must be the work of 1 or 2 people

**1300 – Group-Bed/Wall Quilts (O)**

Any quilt made by 3 or more persons

**Size:** any size is acceptable

**Construction:** pieced or appliquéd, hand or machine or a combination

**Quilting:** any technique is acceptable

**Maker:** 3 or more persons

**1400 – Quilts Made for Children (O)**

Quilt's theme is of primary importance. Colors and design should be appropriate for a child.

**Size:** any size acceptable

**Construction:** Any technique is acceptable

**Quilting:** any technique (including tying) is acceptable

**Maker:** must be the work of 1 or 2 people

**1500 – Quilts Made by Children (E) \*** *(Non-judged category; participation ribbon only)*

Quilt must be made by a child under the age of 18.

**Size:** any size is acceptable

**Construction:** any technique is acceptable

**Quilting:** any technique (including tying) is acceptable

**Maker:** Majority of the work should be done by the child with *limited* adult help allowed.

\* *Children may enter quilts one of two ways:*

**1. A guild member may sponsor a child and that entry will count as one of the guild member's 3 entries. Or....**

**2. The child may enter as a non-member and pay a reduced non-member fee of \$5**

**1600 – Fiber Arts (A, M)**

**Size:** any size is acceptable; may be a garment or quilt

**Construction:** any technique is acceptable

**Quilting:** any technique is acceptable

**Maker:** must be made by an individual

**Judging:** Originality, creative design and artistic expression will be emphasized; workmanship is important, but design will carry more weight

**1700 – Wearable Arts (A, M)**

Piece must be intended to be worn as a garment or as a clothing accessory. Item must be pieced or appliquéd. Must have been completed since July, 2008.

**Construction:** any technique is acceptable

**Quilting:** REQUIRED

**Maker:** individual or group

**1800 – Kit or Block-of-the-Month (O)**

Any quilt made from a kit (purchased pattern with pre-selected fabrics) or a Block-of-the-Month pattern and fabrics purchased from shops, mail order, magazine, etc.

**Size:** any size is acceptable

**Construction:** any technique is acceptable

**Quilting:** any technique is acceptable

**Maker:** individual or group

**1900 – Quilts for Exhibit Only (O)**

Any quilt for display only. No judging or feedback will occur. This category is open to all ages and expertise levels.

**Size:** any size is acceptable

**Construction:** any technique is acceptable

**Quilting:** any technique is acceptable

**Maker:** individual or group
