BASIC LIST OF WORKSHOP SUPPLIES

In addition to the supply list provided for individual workshops, here is a suggested list of supplies you may need for class, depending on the topic. In most cases, be sure to bring paper and pencil for lecture. Some of the following items may or may not be used in every class; however, it's better to be prepared than have to borrow or do without.

PLEASE NOTE: Irons, ironing boards, extension cords, and a design wall will be provided and shared by everyone at the workshop. Because of the power outlet situation in workshop facility, NO EXTRA IRONS WILL BE ALLOWED AT THE TABLES. Thanks for your cooperation.

1. Sewing needles (machine needles and hand sewing needles)
2. Neutral sewing thread
3. Sewing thread to match fabric
4. Thimble
5. Pins
6. Scissors (fabric and cutting)
7. Glue stick, as needed
8. Template material, as needed
9. Sharp pencils
10. Eraser
11. Note/sketch paper
12. Freezer paper (as needed)
13. Small trash bag
14. Rotary cutter
15. Rotary cutting mat
16. Rotary cutting ruler/rulers
17. Portable design wall
18. Fine-tip Sharpie pen
19. Seam ripper
20. Fabric for project (see additional supply list for your workshop)
21. Instructions for pattern for project (see additional supply list for your workshop)
22. Sewing machine
23. Sewing machine cords and manual, as well as extra bobbins, etc.
24. Power strip-personal use
25. Marking pencils (for both dark and light colored fabrics)
26. Sense of humor and willingness to learn
