

# Atomic Starburst

## Cutting Instructions – for Star Blocks ONLY

### 20 Star Blocks:



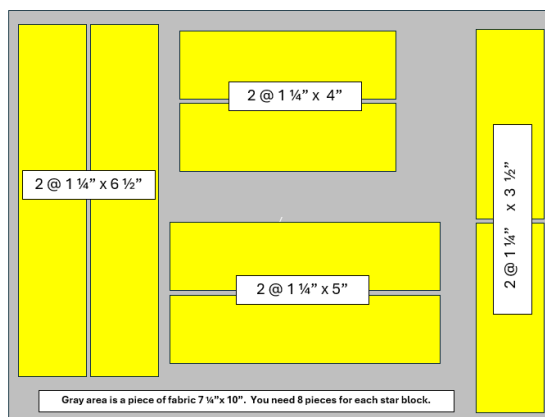
### Color Fabrics – for Star Points

- From each of your 20 star points fabrics – cut the following strips: (*start with rectangles 7 1/4" x 10" and you'll be good – see diagram*)
  - A2/B2 – 2 @ 1 1/4" x 3 1/2"
  - A3/B3 – 2 @ 1 1/4" x 4"
  - A5/B5 – 2 @ 1 1/4" x 6 1/2"
  - A7/B7 – 2 @ 1 1/4" x 5"

### Background Fabric(s)

(see cutting template on next page)

- Cut 10 Strips – 8" X WOF (selvage to selvage). Subcut into **40 rectangles** that measure 8" x 10". (4 per strip) (note – each star uses 2 rectangles: 20 stars=40 rectangles)
- Stack fabric squares **WRONG SIDE UP!!** You should be able to cut through 6-8 fabric squares if you have a nice sharp rotary blade!
- Print out the necessary number of cutting template diagram pages . Place Template (see attached cutting template) on fabrics and paper clip the layers together around the perimeter and cut on lines. Discard the "scrap area" shown by the shaded hashed area. The number in the black circle is the sequence that makes it easiest to cut. Clip each group together by Section Number (number in red).



*As with all foundation paper piecing – there will be some waste. These templates are oversized to help ensure proper coverage. I've also noted the SEW SIDE which will facilitate proper alignment. You'll learn how this works during the workshop.*
