Collage quilts offer a unique opportunity to blend our creativity and quilting loves. Whether you consider yourself a beginner or experienced quilter, everyone can find success in quilt collages. Vickie began quilting more than thirty years ago, but in earnest about 16 years ago. She has been a member of NBAQG for 14-15 of those recent years, so you may know her story. Her program will be primarily a guild trunk show, where she encourages members to share any collage work they have done along with her own for a really fun exhibit.

The two-day workshop is necessary to include time for preparation and (hopefully) completion of your collage quilts.

Note on cost of patterns: Vickie is offering six Laura Heine patterns for you to choose from. You can purchase them from your local quilting store (at retail price) or buy them from her (at a 15% discount). If purchasing patterns from Vickie, you must pay for them when you register for the class, so that you will get them in time to select fabrics. Purchase the pattern at least two months ahead of the workshop through Leslie Prather Forbis (feslie@icloud.com).

Because Vickie is a certified Laura Heine instructor, ONLY Laura Heine collage patterns will be allowed in the workshop, and EACH student MUST have their own pattern — no copying or sharing, as they are copyright protected.

Supplies (in addition to general sewing tools)

- Medium (teal) Karen Kay Buckley serrated scissors
- Appliqué pressing sheet
- Steam-A-Seam II
- Precision Quilting Fusing Mat (this is great for the mini's especially, but not absolutely necessary)
- LOTS of beautiful fabrics—just when you think you have enough, get 10 more fat quarters!

NOTE: Mesquite Bean quilt shop in San Antonio has agreed to have a pop-up shop at our workshop and will have many of these items available for purchase.

No sewing machine is necessary.
