

Fabric Coloring 101 Class! Learn to Use Fabric Markers, Gel Pens, Paints and Inkense Pencils on a 16 Inch Embroidered Block!

Even if you don't sew, if you can color in a coloring book you can color on fabric! Here is the best part of this class: you just show up! Michele will provide a block (for this class it will be a 16 inch block stitched out in black as seen above) and a coloring box full of her tools. You will learn several basic techniques on how to color on fabric as well as how to bling your block (if you so choose). When the class is done you will have a beautiful block to use in a quilt, pillow or on a bag!

Here is what is contained in the supplies that Michele brings for each student to use (please note that the students get to keep their colored block but not the tools themselves):

1. One ¹²16 inch by ¹²16 inch block embroidered with black Isacord thread using a pattern of choice by the guild. Many of the blocks are on my website www.medinadomarts.com. I also can provide a class catalog of the many blocks available for classes. This block will be completely colored in class.
2. A coloring box that includes: 6-8 Inkense pencils, 4-6 Fabrico markers, 4-6 Gel Pens, two paint brushes, fabric medium and tweezers. Optional watercolor pencils and/or crayons may also be in the supply box depending on the pattern chosen.
3. Each student will receive a free container of bling. I bring mini irons for two-three students to share in order to apply bling to their work.
4. Paper instructions are provided if necessary. (Some patterns are quite simple enough that instructions are no necessary.)
5. Paper towels, protective table covers, water containers and other cleaning supplies are provided by the instructor. Each student is encouraged to wear casual clothes with short sleeves to keep potential spills from ruining clothes. No aprons are necessary.
