

Oh Scrap! Improv is a fun, no rules, free to be me, class. Your quilt will be as unique as you, like your signature. You have to let go and let the fabrics and piecing guide you.

You will learn a variety of techniques to practice and play with. Then you will be set free to create your own one of a kind quilt. Come with an open mind and learn a new way to use up all those scraps. After all, everyone needs to make room for new fabrics.

### Oh Scrap! Supply List

FABRICS; A large variety of scraps, any and all sizes. Be sure to include full width fabrics for cutting long strips. Bring a variety of values (light, medium, dark) and scale (small, medium, large). Choose a combination of fabrics that is pleasing to you, plus, more. Do not limit yourself. This is also a great time to use up orphan blocks and strips, so bring those too. You also need a couple of POP colors to give your quilt a WOW factor. For instance, I used black and white prints with my bright colors. I also added a small amount of “control” fabric to tie it all together. In my sample, I used an ombré.

### MISCELLANEOUS;

General sewing supplies

Sewing machine in good working condition with a new needle

Rotary cutter with new sharp blade

Personal size cutting mat

Personal size iron and wool mat

Mister or spray bottle with water or starch type product

Sixth Finger or stiletto

¼” foot on your sewing machine

Knee lift is very helpful

Creative Grids Folded Corner Clipper or similar ruler

OPTIONAL:

Square ruler for squaring up blocks

Long ruler for cutting strips

Graph paper

Clapper
